Jon Janke with the Coon Creek Watershed District completed a turtle sweep between stations 12+00 and 32+00. working upstream to maintain visibility. At the time of the sweep water clarity enabled visual inspection of the creek bottom to a depth of approximately 1 feet with polarized sunglasses. Using waders, Jon walked the thalweg feeling for turtles and focusing on areas deeper than 2 feet with soft bottom sediment. Did not locate any turtles of any species during the sweep. Did find smooth smooth cobble size rocks and many sticks. No signs or evidence of any turtles on lofting logs or the many exposed sand bars. Many tracks of other wildlife. Inspected terrestrial site access and backwaters and found no turtles. Most of the creek was below 2 feet in depth with firm sandy/gravely bottom.

Note- Jon Janke spoke with the contractor, several park goers, and the parks maintenance staff about the turtle sighting the day prior and all indicated that they have never seen a blandings turtle in the park or on the project site but have seen and received other reports of snapping turtles which are frequently observed in the park this time of year.

There was a report of an unidentified turtle crossing the Coon Rapids Dam Regional Park road. Justine Dauphinais with the Coon Creek Watershed District performed a turtle sweep on 6/5/25 from 4-515p in the following locations: the staging site, entire length of the access road, and the floodplain and in-channel area of the two meanders immediately upstream of the streambank currently under construction. Did **not** encounter any turtles or nesting areas. Spoke with the foreman onsite who was not aware of any turtle sightings in the project area aside from 2 snapping turtles last week. In the event of a future blandings sighting, reminded him to document and report any encounters via the online form and to not disturb the turtle unless it is in imminent danger and needs to be relocated. Confirmed that we will continue to recheck upstream areas as construction progresses.







Jon Janke with the Coon Creek Watershed District obtained preconstruction turbidity readings and completed a turtle sweep of the Lower Coon Creek Corridor Restoration project between stations 29+00-43+00. Turbidity of Coon Creek prior to construction was 12-15 NTU from water samples taken at station 43+00. The USGS monitoring station upstream of the project site at Vale St indicated the flow of Coon Creek at the time of the survey was approximately 72 cfs. There was no precipitation with the 48 hours prior to the survey.

Jon Janke with the Coon Creek Watershed District completed a turtle sweep starting downstream at station 43+00 working upstream to maintain visibility. At the time of the sweep water clarity enabled visual inspection of the creek bottom to a depth of approximately 2 feet with polarized sun glasses. Using waders Jon walked the thalweg feeling for turtles and focusing on areas deeper than 2 feet with soft bottom sediment. Did not locate any turtles of any species during the sweep. Did find smooth glass bottle, small plastic bucket, smooth cobble size rocks and many sticks. No signs or evidence of any turtles on lofting logs or the many exposed sand bars with low water level. Many tracks of other wildlife. Inspected terrestrial site access and backwaters and found no turtles. Most of the creek was below 2 feet in depth. About 300 lf was 3-4 ft deep but with hard bottoms. About 50 lf was 4 ft deep with mostly hard bottom but some soft sediment deposit from adjacent eroded bank. This area was surveyed thoroughly but no evidence of turtles was detected. Note-Offsite-painted turtles were easily observed in ponds and lofting logs providing evidence that turtles in general were out of hibernation and active.
