Before disposing of medications, make sure all personal information is removed from the medication by blacking it out with a dark permanent marker

If you can't reach a disposal location, **don't flush your medications**! (There are exceptions for some potentially dangerous medications- the FDA website lists them).

If you have to dispose of medicines and can't access a take back location, the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency website lists how manage unwanted medication.

Medication take back locations are the best way to dispose of unwanted medications. Use them- protect the health of your family, your community, and your environment.
