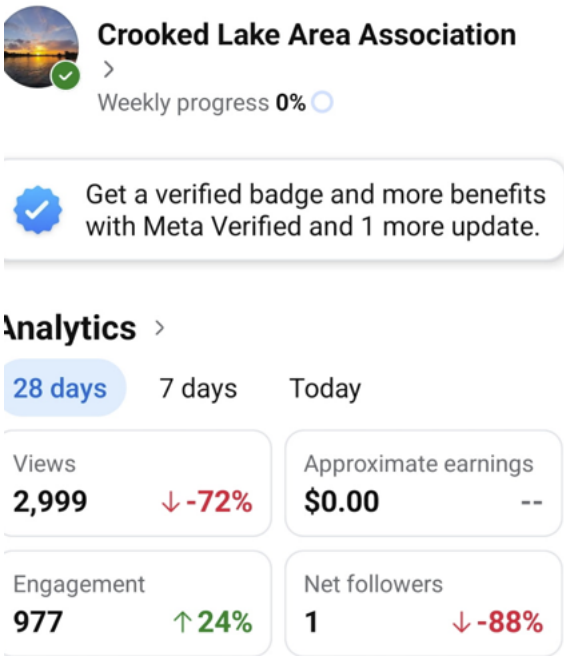

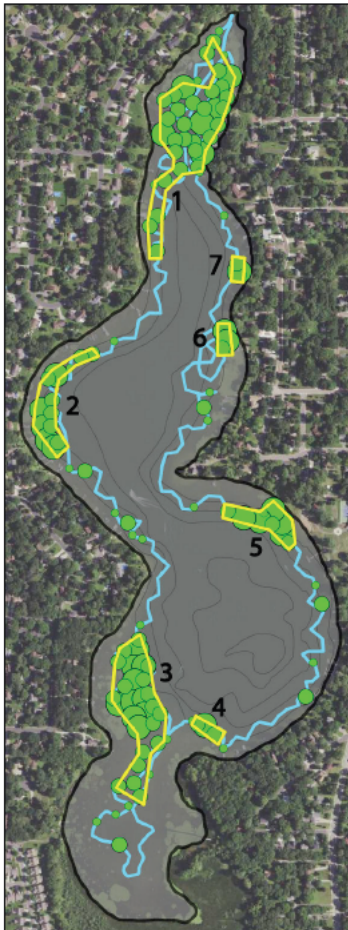

CCWD update	JD update: • Lake monitoring looking normal A-/B+ likely” • JJ showed photos of Brian Graves concern “On our side only (East shoreline from the park south) for the past month or more we have had a green sludge that won't go away no matter how much you rake out, and it is making the sand bottom mucky. Never seen this before in 27 years and would love some input from Justine and the DNR on what is going on. Is it from treatments, low water level, a new plant or something else? JD will look into it – but seems “normal”. • City of Andover approached CCWD with 2027 planning for reconstruction storm water erosion in amount of \$20,000.
